Each resident will receive a 96 gallon wheeled trash container and an 18 gallon recycling bin. These items will be delivered to each resident the week of December 28<sup>th</sup>.

Trash Days will be- Monday and Thursday

Recycling Day will be- Monday

**TRASH COLLECTION-HELPFUL HINTS:**

- **COLLECTION TIME**-trash must be placed for collection the night before the scheduled collection day
- **UNLIMITED HOUSEHOLD TRASH**
- **YARD WASTE**- as of 7-26-90 the state of Pennsylvania enacted Act 101 which prohibits the collecting of refuse consisting primarily of yard waste. We will accept up to 4 bags, cans, or bundles per week. ( branches / twigs must be bundled and tied in lengths not exceeding 4 feet) No dirt, soil, or rocks can be collected
- **BULK ITEMS**- your service includes one bulk item per month such as mattresses, box springs, furniture, carpet (carpet must be cut into 4 foot lengths and 4 foot widths, rolled and tied), and appliances ( non-CFC /freon items). For construction debris and household cleanups please contact our office to arrange for a temporary container.
- **CFC ITEMS**- please contact our office to arrange for the collection of any refrigerators, air conditioners or similar items at an additional charge.
- **PROHIBITED ITEMS**- the following items can not be collected with your household waste:
  - tires
  - auto parts
  - bricks / or concrete
  - car batteries
  - paint containers ( can be accepted if completely empty or dry-no free flowing liquids. Place cans with lids removed next to your regular trash.)
  - liquid chemicals such as motor oil, chlorine etc...

### RESIDENTIAL RECYCLABLE COLLECTION- HELPFUL HINTS:

- **COLLECTION TIME** - recyclables must be placed for collection the night before the scheduled collection day
- **PREPARATION** - bottles, cans, and plastic may be mixed together in the recycle bin. All items must be empty, free of food residue, and no lids. The newspaper should be placed in a brown paper bag or bundled and tied with string and then placed into the recycle bin. Do not over fill as the wind will distribute the papers around your neighborhood.
- **GLASS** - we accept clear, green, and brown glass.  
**DO NOT** recycle dishes, light bulbs, drinking glasses, pyrex, ceramics or window glass.
- **CANS** - this includes aluminum, tin, and bi-metal cans.  
**DO NOT** recycle foil trays, scrap aluminum, or aluminum foil.
- **PLASTICS** - this includes #1 through #7 plastics. (plastics are marked on the bottom of the container in a triangle made of arrows-indicated in the arrows would be a #1 through #7 or marked with the initials PET or HDPE)  
**DO NOT** recycle plastic shopping bags or Styrofoam.
- **NEWSPAPER** - included with the recycling of newspaper would be any glossy print, junk mail, magazines, phone books, office/copy paper. Cardboard is acceptable but please bundle into stacks no bigger than 10 inches thick by 2 feet by 2 feet.  
**DO NOT** recycle any pizza boxes, cartons which have a foil layer, or shredded paper.
- **Please DO NOT over fill any containers.** The material will fall out while we are servicing or will be blown around your neighborhood. We cannot be responsible if over loaded.
